- 3: Data provided by parties with a financial interest in the sale of or financing of the subject property must be verified by a disinterested source.
- 4: Floor plan must be included with the report that includes interior walls and exterior dimensions. United States Appraisals is partnering with a disinterested 3rd party to obtain the floor plan. The floor plan will be provided to you. Please do not submit the report without the floor plan.
